

Smokey Ridge Muzzleloader Camp Rules – 2020

(Camp rules are in effect as soon as you enter the grounds)

- **Please follow all social distancing guidelines to prevent the spread of COVID-19.**
- Dog soldiers wearing red armbands will be around the encampment. Any problems should be addressed to these individuals. Booshway has final say.
- Pre-1840 dress is encouraged during all activities. An attempt should be made by all individuals to make the encampment as authentic as possible.
- The Seneca does require full dress. You must compete in dress in all other events in order to win a prize.
- Blue jeans are not allowed for any shoot, unless this is your first vour. For any first-time shooter, leniency will be shown so you can participate this year. Any seasoned vouser will gladly help if you would like to improve your status beyond novice next year.
- When on the firing range, observe all safety rules when using black powder. No smoking or alcohol on the firing range.
- No loaded mortars, loaded charges, fireworks or loaded guns in the camp area.
- No trespassing in the sawmill area. No children allowed on lumber piles, log piles or other equipment on site. Please keep children in immediate camp area.
- **Animals/dogs must be contained in; not near, by or around your camp. Animals/dogs must be on 6 ft. leash if taken out of your camp. Owners: Clean up after animals.**
- No children under the age of 14 in the shooting area or at the hawk block unless accompanied by an adult.
- This is a pre-1840s camp. Use of mobile devices for pictures is allowed, but please keep devices out of sight at all other times. If you have to text, email or call, please do so within your lodge and be mindful and courteous of other campers.
- **No vehicles in camp** - vehicles must be removed from camp upon completion of "unloading & setup". Park in the designated area and once parked you cannot drive your vehicle back into camp. No vehicles allowed in camp before the noon mortar on Monday.
- Fire pits must be extinguished, and sod replaced.
- Firewood and water are provided for your convenience. Please use them sparingly so there is enough for all campers. Return unused firewood to storage bins before leaving and **do not** throw unused firewood in the timber.
- Practice between events, relax, have fun and enjoy our hospitality. If you have any questions or problems during your stay with us, please feel free to talk to any of our members or officers.
- All garbage and litter must be taken with you -- no dumpster provided by SRM.
